In consideration for the Club permitting the above player to participate in CTS Club Volleyball
program, Parent/Player agree to the following

- Parent/Player understands that the Club's Volleyball season will take place approx. from Dec-May
- Parent/Player understands that minimum playing time is NOT guaranteed.
- Parent/Player assumes the risk and accepts transfer of the Player to a nearby hospital, if necessary.

- Parent/Player agrees that Player shall make a commitment to play for the Club for the full duration of the above referenced season.
- Parent/Player understand that they are expected to act in a sportsman-like manner. If there is a dispute with another player or parent then the player/parent is expected to contact the club director and/or coach in order to resolve said dispute. If there is a dispute with a coach then the player/parent is expected to contact the club director. If there is a dispute with the club director then the club administrator can serve as a mediator. Yelling or acting in a disrespectful manner towards other players or parents, coaches, referees, or other staff will not be tolerated and could be grounds for reduced playing time and/or removal of parent or player from the team.
- Parent/Player understands that players are encouraged to voice any concerns to coaching staff before parents are involved in a dispute. Parents should refrain from involving themselves unless the player has made a solid attempt at resolving an issue with the coach themselves. If a parent is concerned about an issue and wants to get involved, we ask that parents wait 24 hours before bringing said issue to the coach. Sometimes these issues are resolved or the coach will address it with the involved player at a quieter time.
- Parent/Player understands that absences or tardiness must be reported to coach and/or club director 24 hours in advance unless an emergency. Unreported absences and/or tardiness will negatively impact playing time.
- Player/Parent understands that they will be expected to arrive early to tournaments. Coaches will designate a time that players should start warming up, players should be ready for play before that time.
- Player/Parent understands that it is the responsibility of the player and/or parent to make sure the player arrives with all necessary gear for games and practices. Courtside will provide jerseys, spandex, and warm-ups, but knee-pads, sports shoes, and accessories are the responsibility of the parent and/or player.
- Player is encouraged to make responsible decisions about their body's health, including avoiding unhealthy food or substances such as tobacco, alcohol, or drugs. What you put in your body determines its output on game day.
- Parent/Player understands that the estimated fees & costs assessed for Player's participation
 - **\$190 NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT DUE UPON SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, payment is factored into fees. If paying by installment then the full fee due is listed below. Deposit of \$190 is reserved from that amount.**
 - \$1145 via Payment Plan or \$1045 Paid in Full for 12/13/14u age level participants – first payment by installment is \$195, \$190 due on the 1st of each month until fully paid. Last payment will be due April 25th, the last day of practice.

- \$1545 via Payment Plan or \$1445 Paid in Full for 15/16u age level participants – first payment by installment is \$260, \$257 due on the 1st of each month until fully paid. Last payment will be due April 25th, the last day of practice.
- \$1645 via Payment Plan or \$1545 Paid in Full for 17/18u age level participants – first payment by installment is \$275, \$274 due on the 1st of each month until fully paid. Last payment will be due April 25th, the last day of practice.
- Player/Parent understands that these fees and costs are NON-REFUNDABLE in the event Player is suspended from the Club or voluntarily terminates participation prior to or during the season.
- Player/Parent agrees to make timely payment of all fees and costs set forth herein
- In the event there are any travel, lodging or meal costs for Player which are above and beyond the assessed fees to participate in the Club Player/Parent agrees to be solely responsible for these costs

If Player/Parent does not timely pay the fees and costs owed to the Club, Club may suspend the Player/Parent and seek to enforce the terms of this agreement through legal means. If Club is forced to incur fees and costs in an effort to collect on amounts owed by Player/Parent, Player/Parent specifically agrees to pay all legal fees and costs incurred by Club.
